



#### **ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE - ASSESSMENTS**

The federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires states to assess their learning standards for English language arts (ELA), mathematics, and science. Each state may also have a general assessment for the majority of its students, and an alternate assessment for the one percent of students with the most significant cognitive disabilities. ESSA also requires that English Learners be assessed in four domains (reading, writing, speaking and listening) each year until they reach proficiency. Results are presented both by subject (all tests combined) and then by individual test.

Each Performance Level is defined by a range of overall scale scores for the assessment. There are five Performance Levels for IAR assessments:

- · Level 1: Did not yet meet expectations
- · Level 2: Partially met expectations
- Level 3: Approached expectations
- Level 4: Met expectations
- Level 5: Exceeded expectations

Students performing at levels 4 and 5 met or exceeded expectations, have demonstrated readiness for the next grade level/course and, ultimately, are on track for college and careers. Performance Level Descriptors describe the knowledge, skills, and practices that students should know and be able to demonstrate at each Performance Level in each content area (ELA and mathematics) and at each grade level/course.

## **Dynamic Learning Maps - Alternative Assessment (DLM-AA)**

DLM-AA results are not based on raw or scale scores; all data is based on diagnostic classification modeling. Standard setting allows us to look at patterns of number of linkage levels mastered across the tested Essential Elements, to which we can apply cut points to define categories of student performance. This performance are reported using the four performance levels approved by the consortium:

- Level 1 -- Entry The student demonstrates **emerging** understanding of and ability to apply content knowledge and skills represented by the Essential Elements.
- Level 2 --Foundational The student's understanding of and ability to apply targeted content knowledge and skills represented by the Essential Elements is approaching the target.
- Level 3 -- Satisfactory The student's understanding of and ability to apply content knowledge and skills represented by the Essential Elements is at target.
- Level 4 -- Mastery The student demonstrates **advanced** understanding of and ability to apply targeted content knowledge and skills represented by the Essential Elements.
